What's Happening

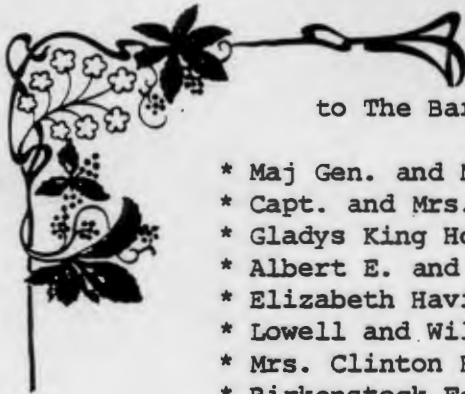
Are you concerned about recent developments?
