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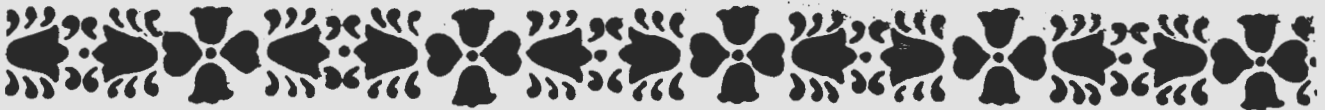
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ADAM WEILAND is the new Historic Research Director, replacing Vicky Berry who had to resign.
