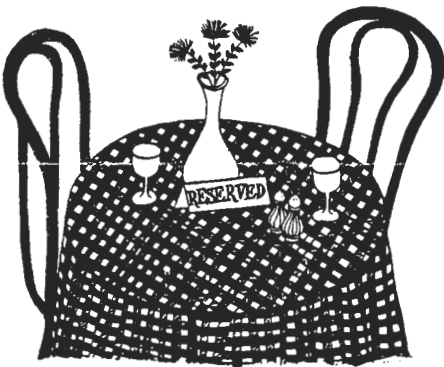

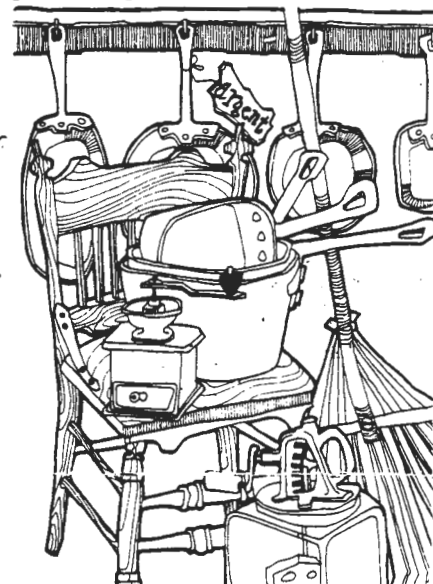

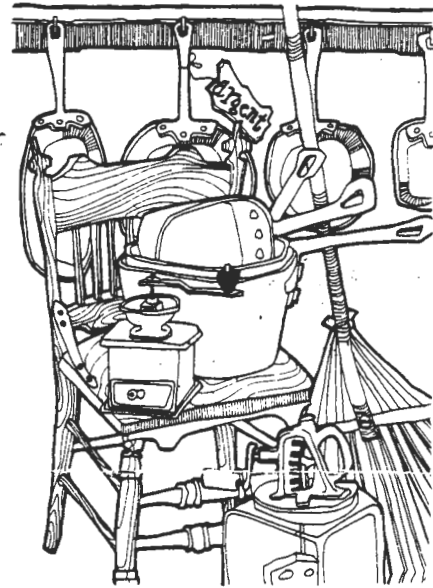

TWO HOURS A WEEK:

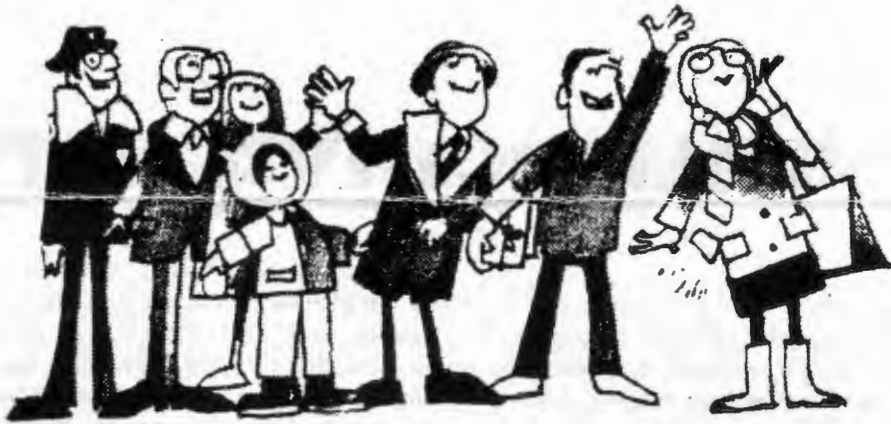
