Preparations are being finalized for "Heritage Stars," the Seventh Annual Quilt Show co-sponsored by the Heritage Society of Pacific Grove and the Monterey Peninsula Quilters Guild.

The show, which will feature 86 quilts, will be held Saturday and Sunday, March 27 and 28, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., in Chautauqua Hall, at 16th and Central in Pacific Grove. Admission is \$2.25; senior citizens will be admitted for \$1.50.

The Heritage Star quilt which is to be raffled off is being displayed at Wild Goose Quilt Shop, Countrymart and Country-wide Crafts.

On Sunday, March 28, at 3 p.m. Ginny Beyer, noted quilt authority, will give a lecture at St. Mary's Parish Hall.
