Some of our members are presently involved in the Restoration/Preservation of the Chautauqua Hall. Contact Dave Korhonen (649-4556) for further details if you are interested.

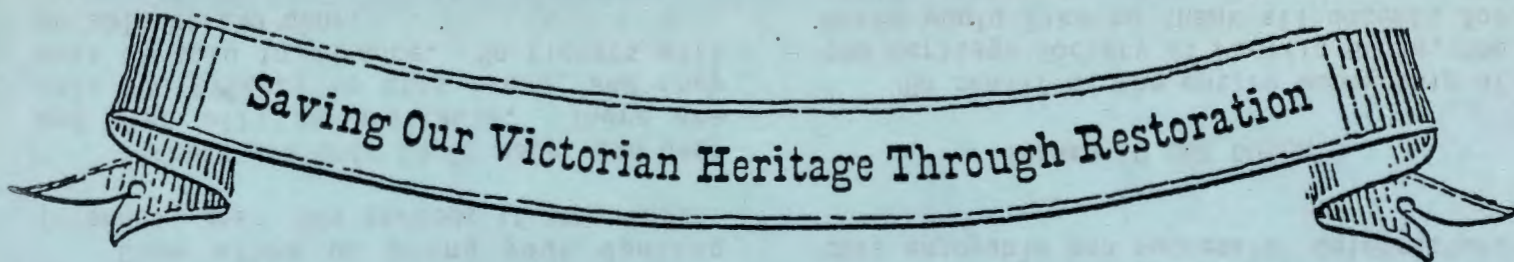
LAURELS TO THE TRIBUNE
